



# THE POOCH AND THE PARK

## The city is home to several parks made just for pups and their people.

These dog parks are where you'll find pooches of all shapes and sizes doing their daily meet-and-greet, with tails wagging and tongues wagging. Before setting off on a park jaunt, find one near you—we list them below—and check out the rules on the city's dog park site ([www.cabq.gov/parks/dogparks.html](http://www.cabq.gov/parks/dogparks.html)). These aren't rules meant to be broken; they include not bringing puppies younger than six months or unaccompanied humans younger than 12 years into the park, taking aggressive dogs home, and making sure all dogs are licensed and vaccinated, ensuring that you and your pup are safe and sound.

- USS Bullhead Park:** 1606 San Pedro SE (bring your own water)
- Westgate Community Park:** Valley View & El Patron Rd. SW (bring your own water)
