The Purpose of Discipleship

Discipleship is a process of becoming more and more like Christ. God does not want you and me to just be informed about Jesus, he wants you and me to become the “spitting image” of Jesus.

He is preparing us to walk once again with Him in the garden in the cool of the day, just as Adam and Eve once did in the Garden of Eden. For right now, He wants us to impart His great love for us to others in whom we come in contact. Discipleship is the transition from selfishness to selflessness and self-centeredness to Christ-centeredness.

But how can we become “other-centered” and “Christ-focused?”

The Process of Discipleship

Connect in worship to God through salvation in Christ Jesus, **Grow** in your relationship to Jesus through daily discipleship and mentoring, **Serve** and care for others in small groups, ministry and outreach opportunities, and **Go** reach others with the same loving message of Jesus Christ that captured and connected you to the Body of Christ.



The Cost of Discipleship

Salvation did not personally cost us anything – it was a free gift, but discipleship will cost us everything. Salvation occurs in a moment, but the process of discipleship takes a lifetime. If we truly want to live a life of discipleship, then there will be things to accept and things to reject. The road will not always be smooth, but it will always be a blessing that glorifies The Very One who set our feet upon the path. If you are a disciple, there will be times when you want to quit, but you must never give up. Everything that matters for eternity was based in the death of the Son of God. Gaining what is most valuable is hard. Don’t waste your life **trying** Christianity. Die to self and gain all that the Heavenly Father has to give. Make your death count. Raise your hand only if you’re ready to see it through to the end.
