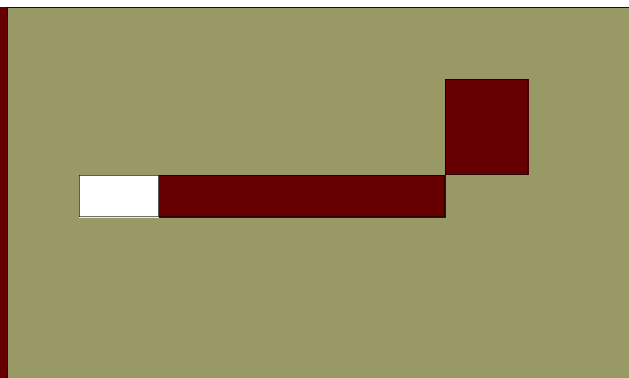

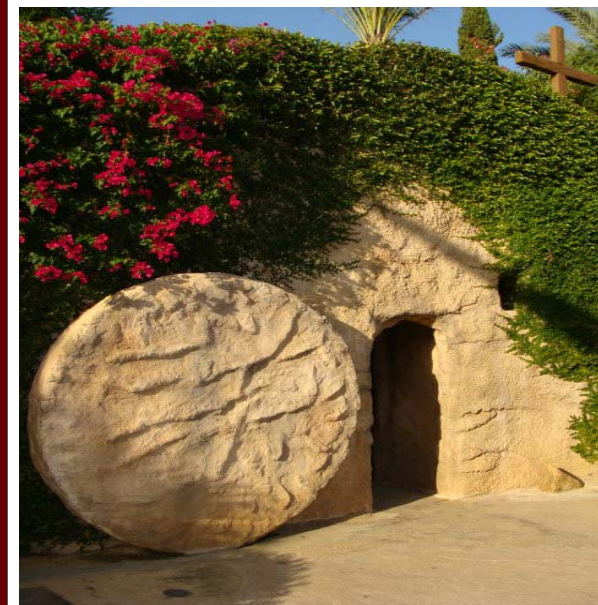

St. Augustine is the nation's oldest city. You will travel, with our tour guide, along the bay front and through the heart of the old city. Hear the story of Henry Flagler the "Father of Florida Tourism." View churches and hotels Flagler built.



You will tour the beautiful Flagler Memorial Presbyterian Church built by Flagler in 1889 in memory of his daughter.

At the Old Florida you will visit a Timucua Indian chief's hut, and learn how the local natives lived. You will dip candles like the Spanish colonists did, and take your candle taper home as a souvenir.

In St. Augustine you will dine at Harry's Grill and Salt Water Cowboys. Harry's is located in one of St. Augustine's oldest bay homes. Built in the 1740's it is just steps from the Bridge of Lions. Salt Water Cowboys has been serving fresh food to locals and tourists for 31 years. Your deluxe continental breakfast at the Quality Inn Historic hotel will include offerings like waffles, eggs bagels and fresh fruit.
