Camp Tips

1. Please label all of your child's clothing and items with his/her first and last name (This includes disposable cameras as well).
2. Please pack clothing appropriate to the dress code.
3. Canteen cards are available for purchase for the camper to use in the junkyard. Canteen Cards can be purchased in any amount either as part of pre-registration or on registration day. All food/drink items in the junkyard are priced between 50¢ and \$1.00 and there are three canteens a day.
4. Please make sure your child has a least one set of old clothing to wear (that can be thrown away if necessary); as some of our fun activities can be extremely messy.
5. If your child has any special medical or dietary needs, please call the office in advance to discuss these with the Director. This will help us best take care of your child.
6. If your child has to bring medicine to take while at camp, please label the bottle with his/her name and make sure that it is labeled with his/her cabin number upon being assigned to a cabin at registration. ***If the medicine is a prescription, it must be prescribed to the camper that brings it.***
7. We no longer accept church billing forms, but we do now accept MasterCard and Visa for payment. All camper's registrations must be paid in full on or before registration day.
8. Just a reminder, due to increasing enrollment, we can no longer take request for cabin mates and counselors. If you have a particular camper or counselor that you would like your child to room with, please arrive early and we will accommodate you if possible.
9. All items left at camp will be held in the lost and found for 30 days after the last day of camp. After 30 days, all items remaining in the lost and found will be donated to charity.
