

Church Meetings

Section 1 - Worship Services

The church shall meet regularly each Sunday morning and evening for preaching, instruction, evangelism, and for the worship of the Almighty God, and on Wednesday evening for prayer and Bible study. These meetings will be open for the entire membership of the church and for all people, and shall be conducted under the direction of the pastor.

Section 2 - Regular or Special Business Meetings

Regular business meetings shall be held monthly on a designated Wednesday night, this Wednesday shall be the first the Wednesday after the third Sunday as much as practical with adequate notice. Should there be any unusual business or matter of unusual interest to be brought before such regular monthly meeting, notice shall be given to the membership two regular worship services prior to the meeting – with the object of the meeting being clearly stated.

Section 3 - Parliamentary Rules

Robert's Rules of Order is the authority for parliamentary rules of procedure for all business meetings of the church.

Section 4 - Year Fiscal

The fiscal year of the church shall run concurrently with the church year, which begins on January 1 and ends on December 31.

Amendments

Changes in this constitution and by-laws may be made at any regular business meeting of the church, provided such amendments shall have been presented in writing or posted on the church website at a previous business meeting and copies of the proposed amendment be made available to any person who wishes to have a copy. Amendments to the constitution shall be by two-thirds vote of all members of the church present entitled to vote; amendments to the by-laws shall have a concurrence of a majority of the members present voting.

A supply of constitutions shall be made available to any and all members.
