We are encouraged by their public proclamation and demonstration of faith.

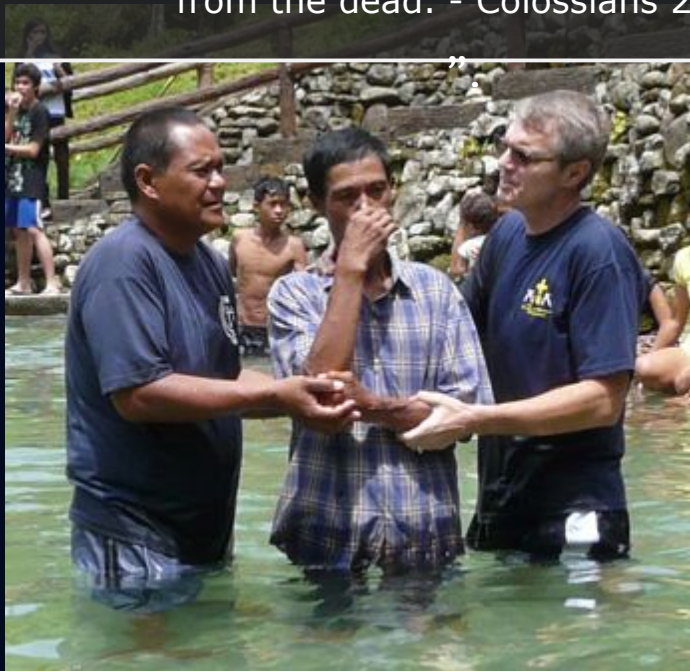


As we entered the “pool” we soon learned that the water in the pool was from the river and it was **ice cold**.
