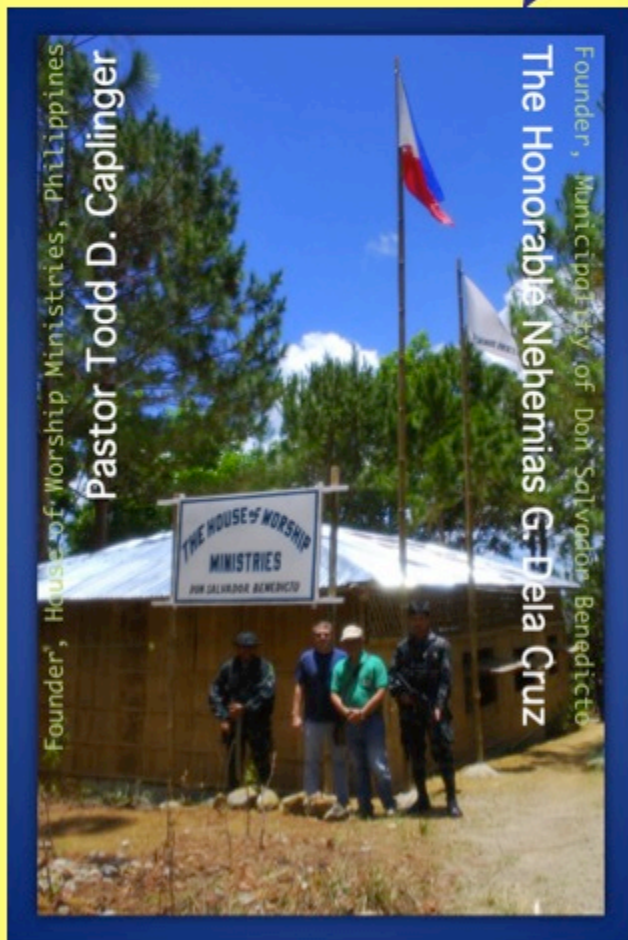

Please look at the picture below to get a better visual. The church is on the left. The additional land being granted is to the right where the shanty is situated.



The plan is to erect a structure that will house the children's Sunday school. **We want to design this to facilitate a future preschool in this location.**

The population of teens in the church has exploded, so we want to incorporate an area to accommodate them as well.

We did not anticipate this **double portion of property** when we designed the original plan.

In order to fulfill this additional vision we anticipate needing \$3000.00.

This was after he informed us that we are the first church in the history of this island to be given legal usage of land.

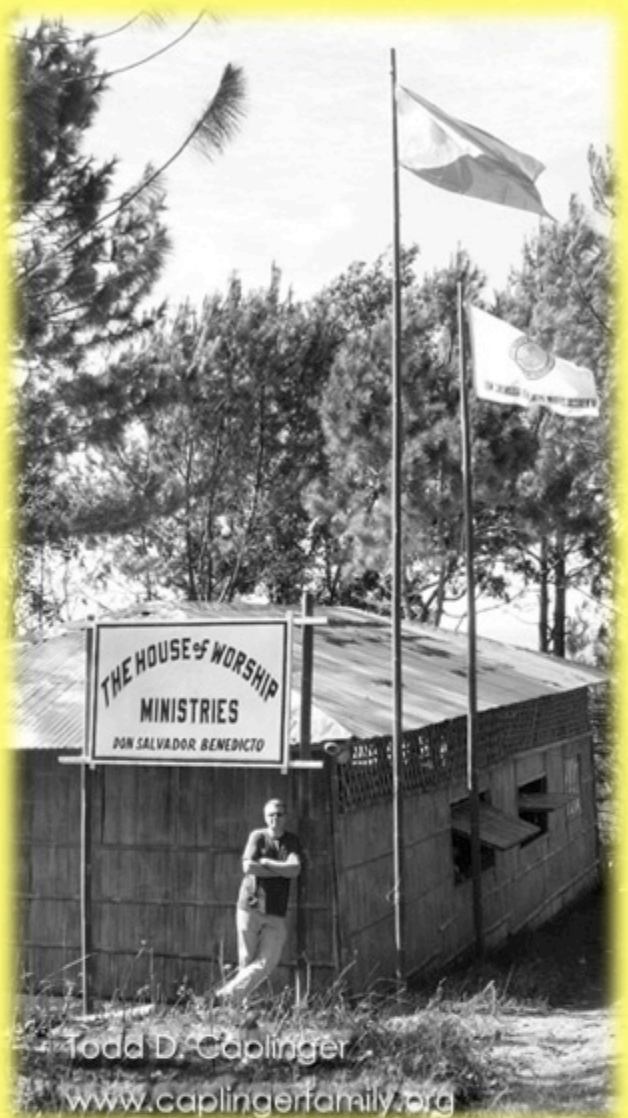
God continually amazes us!
